#### **Registration Period:**

October 16<sup>th</sup> – December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2025

As of this year, the entire application process will be online via PDF fillable documents. Application packets will be available via <a href="www.PARATHOSI.com">www.PARATHOSI.com</a> on September 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2024. All documents are due no later than December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2025. It is imperative that these documents are not late so that proper planning and scheduling of the event can begin. Any registration packets turned in after December 1<sup>st</sup> cannot guarantee your team the ability to participate in PARATHOSI 2026.

#### **Divisions:**

**Senior Division** – This classification will be scored by our judges – Avg. ages 18+

**Division 1** – This classification will be scored by our judges – Avg. ages 15-17

**Division 2** – This classification will be scored by our judges – Avg. ages 12-14

**Division 3** – This classification will be scored by our judges – Avg. ages 9-11

**Division 4** – This classification is exhibition only – Avg. ages 8 & under.

#### **Cost of Participation:**

- The cost of registration for PARATHOSI 2026, is \$95 per participant.
- There will be a \$650 per organization fee (regardless of the # of teams submitted)
- Lunch will be available for purchase at LI Marriott's restaurant
- PARATHOSI 2026 Awards Glendi will be held at LI Marriott in Melville following the conclusion of the performances. Cocktail Hour begins at 6:00 p.m., dinner with music begins at 7:00 p.m.
  - o Adults \$160 per ticket
  - o Participants over 21 \$110
  - o Participants under 21/ Non-participant Children- \$85 per ticket
  - o Children under 5 \$40

- Every team must have a parish priest sign their roster. (Electronic signatures acceptable via PDF fillable documents). If you choose to sign documents by hand, we please ask that you first fill-out all documents online. Please scan the documents and return to us at <a href="mailto:PARATHOSI@goarch.org">PARATHOSI@goarch.org</a>. All documents must be compiled for your entire team before they are to be sent. Packets with missing documents will not be accepted.
- All teams must have dues paid in full no later than December 1st, 2025 in order to participate in PARATHOSI 2025.

#### Judging:

OUR VISION: To present authentic Greek Dance in as "natural" a setting as possible.

We strive to learn, and present, authentic Greek dances that represent what was, or what is, being danced in the villages and regions we present, by the people who live or lived in those villages and regions. We shy away from overly choreographed dances that are not based on and grounded in the tradition. Our best teachers and styles to emulate are those of the older people in the villages and towns, as they perform these dances for themselves at their own festivals and gatherings.

#### Competition Format:

- 1 suite per team or 1 collection of dances per team
- Time frame for each division will be as follows:
  - **Division 1 & Seniors:** 10 12 minutes
    - o **Division 2 & 3:** 8-10 minutes
    - o **Division 4:** 5-7 minutes
- Staging Entrance, exit, coordination, transitioning from one dance to another
- There will be a weighted point system:
  - o Correctness of Dance 10 points
  - o Correctness of Style 10 points
  - Group Synergy 5 points
  - o Preparation 10 points
- Points will be awarded on the respective scale in each category
- Total number of points that can be awarded is 35
- The judges will also have the ability to award half points when necessary.
